

Important Information Regarding Water Restrictions

On April 18, 2007, the director of the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) declared a **level two drought response** across the state and will require all Georgians to follow a more stringent outdoor water use schedule.

A level two drought response declaration limits outdoor water use to mornings only.

Statewide, the new outdoor watering schedules are as follows:

- **Odd-numbered addresses may water on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays from 12:00 a.m. (midnight) to 10:00 a.m. (No watering allowed from 10:01 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.)**
- **Even-numbered and un-numbered addresses may water on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays from 12:00 a.m. (Midnight) to 10:00 a.m. (No watering allowed from 10:01a.m. to 11:59 p.m.)**
- **Watering on Fridays is prohibited.**

THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

These level two drought restrictions will remain in effect until further notice is received from the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division (EPD). The EPD will continue to monitor conditions statewide, and issue revised drought declarations as necessary.

The City of Statesboro's Water Department is asking all customers to comply with these restrictions. In advance, we appreciate your cooperation.
